

# The 1976 SIMMONS CUP TRIAL

## Start and finish at Canada Heights

### Present Day Note:

There is no programme or Results in the Sidcup Club archives. Has anyone out there either?

The December 1976 issue of The Compass asked for observers at Canada Heights by 9:30am. Sections will be at Canada Heights, Jackson's Gully and Bourne Wood "*so nobody will be far from home and the event should be over in the early afternoon.*"

There is no report about the Trial in the January or February 1977 Compass. The minutes of the Club Committee Meeting, held the day after the Trial said:-

*"Fairly successful day; 116 starters, only about 20 non-finishers and approx. 25 non-starters. Track went from Canada Heights to Bourne Wood to Jackson's Gully and back to Canada Heights.*

*Criticism from some sidecars that Jacksons was a waste of time – too hard. The Met. Police Club helped out as observers. All in all a good day although certain sources felt the North Kent Trials Combine should have offered more assistance. Vote of thanks to Mrs Cullen as Secretary of Meeting."*
