### SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS

**1 ANNOUNCEMENT:** The Sidcup & DMCC Ltd. will organise a round of the British Sidecar Cross Championship and the National Expert Sidecar Cross Championship on Sunday 6<sup>th</sup> September at Canada Heights Motosport Circuit. It is open to eligible competitors as stated in the 2026 ACU British Sidecar Cross Championship Conditions and solo Adult ACU riders.

**2 JURISDICTION:** The meeting will be held under the current National Sporting Code of the ACU, the Standing Regulations for Motocross, the 2026 ACU British Sidecar Cross Championship conditions and any further Supplementary Regulations or Instructions issued, or official announcements made.

**3. INSURANCE:** The insurance cover for this event will be limit of liability £40M and Medical Malpractice insurance (limit of liability £5m) is included

**3 COURSE:** The course is situated at Canada Heights Motosport Circuit, Button Street, Swanley, Kent. BR8 8DX. Signposted from the M20/M25 roundabout Junction 3 of the M25.

The track is approx.. 1.8kms of sandy hillside terrain with man made jumps. Start method is by metal drop down start gate.

#### 4 ELIGIBILITY:

**Sidecar:** Open to riders and Passengers holding current Motocross licences issued by the ACU and SACU or holding a current National licence issued by their European FMN. Any competitor not holding an ACU or SACU licence must provide proof of Insurance and a written start permission document issued by their FMN.

**Solo:** Open to members of all ACU clubs and holding a 2026 ACU or SACU Motocross licence. Day licences are available.

**5. ENTRIES:** All entries will be made via the **GORACE MX** online platform. Solo Entry opens on 1st August and close 2<sup>nd</sup> September. Or when full' Sidecars open on 1st August and close on 2nd September or when full

**Sidecar:** Riders/Passengers who registered with the ACU **£85.00.**

Entries received after the closing date will incur an additional charge of **£20.00.**

**Solo:** Experts and Juniors - **£61.00.**

**PASSES / VENUE ADMISSION:** Each registered Sidecar Team will be allowed entry for 4 people including the Rider and Passenger. Each Solo rider will be allowed entry for 2 people including the Rider. Anyone else arriving with the Team/Rider will be required to pay the normal admission fee at the entrance gate.

#### 8. GENERAL:

- Tear-offs are not permitted.
- No pit bikes, no electric motorcycles, scooters, Revvis, Osets, etc.
- Use of Electric-assisted cycles by authorised users only.

**9 REFUND POLICY** *Entries cancelled before the closing date will receive a full refund less a £5.00 surcharge*  
*Entries may not be cancelled after the closing date, unless you can produce a doctor's note or a valid reason approved by the Sidcup MCC Committee*

**25 PADDOCK** The riding in the paddock of any pit bikes, electric bikes or mini bikes is not allowed.

FIRE EXTINGUISHERS WILL BE CHECKED AT TECHNICAL & RANDOMLY IN PADDOCK (1 per vehicle)

- The riding in the paddock and circuit of pit bikes, minibikes, push bikes and battery assisted bikes are all not permitted in any circumstances Please take any rubbish home with you, take used tyres away with you as it is an offence not to dispose of them in the correct manner .
- **27 Camping** Overnight Camping in designated area only as directed. from 12.30pm Saturday, Gates Close 9pm, if you cannot comply with these rules please arrive on Sunday.
- Silence in the paddock will commence at **9.30pm**
