Supplementary Regulations.

1. **JURISDICTION:** Held under the National Sporting Code, Environmental Code, Standard Adult Short Course Enduro Regulations of the ACU, the Enduro Regs of the SE Enduro Combine; these Supplementary Regulations and any further instructions that may be issued. Riders from 14 years old and upwards accepted – max c.c. for 14's is 125; max c.c. for 15's is 250.

2. **ENTRIES:** On-line entries using **GORACEMX**, www.goracemx.com, or 'Paper' entries on the form below (**where to send the form and how to pay are on the form**). Open 8:00pm on Sunday 5th July. Close Wednesday 29th July (or earlier when 160 entries have been received). Entry Fee - **£65.00**. A growing list of accepted riders will be on www.sidcupmotorcycleclub.co.uk and updated daily until entries are full or closed.

3. **CLASSES:** (and starting order)



A – Championship

B – Expert

4. **COURSE:** About 6 miles per lap using several parts of the motocross track, woods, field and tracks, without any roadwork.
5. **MEDICATION:** It is your responsibility to declare at signing on if you are taking any drugs, you may be tested.
6. **GENERAL:**
- Lights must be fitted front and rear.
 - Any pattern of tyres are permitted on the front wheel; Enduro pattern on the rear wheel. The Michelin Tracker does not comply.
 - Anyone can enter the Sportsman classes (J and K), not just Enduro newcomers – easier time schedule than Clubman. All classes score SEEC Championship points.
 - Riding numbers will be allocated by the Secretary of Meeting one week before the event. Stick-on race numbers on coloured backgrounds will be given to all riders at sign-on.
