The Results Sheet stated:

It is understood that the Sidcup and District Motor Cycle Club is to be prosecuted for allowing competitors to ride without wearing crash helmets. We hope that, having made their protest at this event, those riders will comply with the current regulation. If they find this impossible, will they please refrain from entering Sidcup trials and make their feelings known by other means.

Unless the present rule is changed before then, all riders in our next trial, the Sidcup Sixty on January 16th 1994, must wear helmets accepted as proper for motorcycling all the time they are riding at the event.
