A large number of people have asked what is the difference between the Sidcup Sixty and the Thirty.

For over 40 years by way of its name, the Sixty had a route of 60 miles between sections from start to finish. It is only since the advent of the modern bike and pocket-handkerchief courses that it has become a regular feature at Canada Heights. The only resemblance to 30 has with the Sixty is that the three lap course is on the Canada Heights estate each lap comprising of 10 super sections, thus the name The Sidcup 30.

The whole idea is that of Reg Playfoot, the Clerk of the Course, who eighteen months ago had this thought of building the super sections, as a number of expert riders had stated to him that they needed more of a challenge.

The challenge has taken a year to prepare and is set for the riders to prove their skills. Good luck to those who have entered; we know that you will enjoy yourselves.
