11 TECHNICAL CONTROL

It is compulsory that riders/passengers wear, as a minimum, back and chest protectors, incorporated within the suit or worn separately. It is advised that all riders and passengers should wear a body belt/kidney protector

14 RACES

CLASSES: Allcomers Groups qualifying for Races race will be decided via timed training using AMD transponders.

South east evo group

The Number of races will be **3 per group** and classes will be **determined by timed practice.**

races may be time restricted or cancelled dependent on time curfew.

15 PROGRAMME

Programme of races on the day **15 if time allows**

16 METHOD OF START

The start will be live engine, clutch type.

Once a rider has taken his position at the start gate, he cannot change it.

A rider is deemed to be under starters orders having been called to the start line, the starter will hold up a green flag from which moment the riders are under his control, until all riders are on the start line. When all the riders are on the start line, the starter will hold up a 15 second board for a full 15 seconds. At the end of the 15 seconds, he will hold up a 5 seconds board and the gate will drop between 5 and 10 seconds after the 5 second Board is shown.

No one except **RIDERS** and **OFFICIALS** shall be permitted to the area of the starting gate. Riders are allowed to groom the area behind the start gate only, provided no tools are used or outside assistance provided.

17 FINISH OF RACE

Riders must complete at least **50%** of the distance of the winner and pass the chequered flag to be classed as a finisher.

18 POINTS

25, 20, 18, 16, 15 then -1 till 0

19 AWARDS

Championship points will be awarded, there will be no material awards until further notice.

20 Prize money

Allcomers A 1st =£250 2nd =£175 3rd =£100 4th =£50 5th =£25

A total of 8 spot prizes of £50 each will also be allocated across all other classes in the south east centre event

21 TIES

Number of wins or if scores equal, last race decides.

22 FLAG SIGNALS

Please take note of the following rule change regarding flag signals:

Yellow Waved: Great Danger, prepare to stop, no overtaking. A significant reduction in speed must be seen; jumps should not be attempted.

White with Red Diagonal Cross Waved: Medical Crew & Officials in attendance on live race track. Proceed with extreme caution, riders must significantly reduce speed and roll each jump individually with no overtaking until past the area of concern. ACU 8.7,

26 PADDOCK

The riding in the paddock of any pit bikes, electric bikes or mini bikes is not allowed.

FIRE EXTINGUISHERS WILL BE CHECKED AT TECHNICAL & RANDOMLY IN PADDOCK (1 per vehicle)

The riding in the paddock and circuit of pit bikes, minibikes, push bikes and battery assisted bikes are all not permitted in any circumstances Please take any rubbish and used tyres home with you.

27 MEDICATION: You may be asked to take part in a drugs test. It is your responsibility to declare at signing on if you are taking any drugs.

Any rider using recreational drugs will be asked to leave the Venue.

28 Camping

Overnight Camping in designated area only, turn left at medic containers, up hill and park behind trees, from 12.30pm Saturday, Gates Close 9pm, if you cannot comply with these rules please arrive on Sunday. Silence in the paddock will commence at 10pm
